For facilitators of *Re-Igniting the Spirit of Caring* or *See Me as a Person*, attendance at all three days of the Annual Gathering are necessary to fulfill your recertification and license requirements.

FOR ALL

Like last year, DAY 1 has been designed as a summit conference which is also open to health care workers in the area. It will be the foundation for DAYS 2 & 3 of the Combined Annual Gathering.
